

Will of Ann Dill Thomas Rowan Co., NC  
NC Will Book A Pg. 158; 19 Dec 1769, Probated Feb. 1770

In the name of God, Amen. I, Ann Thomas the state of North Carolina in Rowan County being very sick and weak in body, but of perfect mind and memory thankful to mortality of my body do make and ordain this my last Will and Testament. That is to say principally and first of all I give and recommend my soul unto the hands of Almighty God that gave it. My body I recommend to the earth to be buried in a Christian manner at the discretion of my executors.

I give and dispoose of in the following manner:

First I give and bequeth to my son John Dills one \_\_\_ money of Great Brittain, also the plantation or tract of land the said Ann Thomas now lives on.

I give and bequeath to my grandson, Henry Dills, the oldest son of my son Peter Dills, also one red brown cow and calf.

Also give to John Dills, the youngest son of Peter Dills, one brown cow with her calf.

Also I give to Mary Yoakly, daughter to Peter Dills, one blanket.

Also I leave all my movable estate except the things already given to John Yoakly & Henry Dills who I make and constitute and the sole executors of my last will and testament and after paying all my lawful debts and the remainder to be divided equally amongst my children, John Dill's children and Peter Dill's children.
