Jesse G. Hoggard Will - 1898
North Carolina,
Bertie County

I, Jesse G. Hoggard of the aforesaid County and State, being of sound mind but considering the uncertainty of my earthly existence do make and declare this my last will and testament,

First my executor, hereinafter mentioned or names shall give my body a decent burial suitable to the wished of my friends and relative, and pay all my funeral expenses, together with all my just debts out of the first money which may come into her hands, belonging to my estate.

Second, I give and bequeath to my wife, Abby Hoggard all my property of every description, consisting of all my land, horses, wagons, carts, cattle, hogs and all other property that I may own at my death not herein mentioned, to have and to hold and use to her best advantage during her natural life and after her death my John H. Hoggard tract of land I will to my daughter, Nancy E. Bazemore, and all other property of every description shall be equally divided my daughter Nancy E. Bazemore, and my son Jessee W. Hoggard.

I hereby constitute and appoint my wife Abby Hoggard my lawful executor to all intents and purposes to execute this my last will and testament, in witness whereof I the said Jessee G. Hoggard do hereunto set my hand and seal this 15th day of March 1898.
