

*Will of John Lee of Onslow County 1788*

*I John Lee of the County of Onslow, North Carolina:*

*Item: I give to my son Henry Lee my land and plantation whereon I now live.*

*Item: I give to my wife Rachel Lee my negro girl Cris and lend to wife all my stock and at her marriage or death to be divided between my children. Also lend to my wife all my plantation tools and all household furnishings except 3 feather beds and at her death or marriage all this to be equally divided between my children.*

*Item: To daughter Abigail Lee one feather bed and furniture.*

*Item: To daughter Sarah Lee one feather bed and furniture.*

*Item: To daughter Mary Lee one feather bed and furniture.*

*Item: To Jacob Lee all my coopers tools and all my turning tools.*

*Item: To daughter Penelope Marshburn 10 shillings.*

*Item: Lend to wife Rachel Negro Peter and Negro George.*

*Item: Give Negro George, after wife's death or marriage to son Henry.*

*Exec. Wife Rachel Lee and my friend Charles Lee.*
