

Will of Joseph Tooke Craven Co. 1805

To my son William, all the property before given into his possession when he removed from this state into the state of Georgia, also two negro girls;

To my daughter Nancy also one tract of land in the county of Onslow near Sayers Tavern four hundred acres more or less;

To my granddaughter Polly Collier one negro boy;

To my son in law John Roach four negroes;

To my son Adam (Isham) 3 negroes, one stud horse, and bed and furniture;

I give unto my daughter Diadema Tooke one negro woman, Chano, one boy Jack, one boy Windsor, two girls Sila and Julia, one bed and furniture to her and her heirs forever;

To my beloved wife Mary Tooke all the residue of the estate both real and personal after all just debts are paid.

Wife Mary and the son William were named Executors.
