University of Alabama Alumni News, May, 1927

The death of Virgil Lee COWART occurred at Detroit, Mich., in April 1927. Mr. COWART was born in Towns County, Ga., March 26, 1866, and was the son of Thomas J. COWART, formerly of Spartanburg, S. C., and Lydia CHASTAIN. When he attended the University he was living in Winston County and received the degree of Bachelor of Laws in 1886. He practiced law and served as county solicitor at Thomasville 1887-1890; was examiner of accounts with the Department of Justice 1893-1895; assistant district attorney for North Alabama, 1895-1898; presidential elector from the 9th District, 1908; private secretary to Governor Emmet O'NEAL from January 16, 1911, until February 3 of the same year when he was appointed commissioner of immigration. He was prominent in the democratic party, was a delegate to the state convention from 1886 to 1894, member of the Jefferson democratic executive committee in 1900 and 1910. He has been a resident of Detroit for several years.

He was past chancellor commander of the Knights of Pythias, past sachem of Red Men, and a member of the Methodist church.

He married Emile SPAIN of Spruce Pine, February 14, 1891, who survives him with three sons and a daughter. [ADDENDUM: Virgil COWART was the grandson of Jonathon COWART, Jr., and Sarah (Sallie) BARNES.]

Linden Coward, in his book on Nathan Coward-Jane Rogers Family, on page 26 writes about the COWARD-SMITH-ALLEN relationship.

Most of you are aware that Dave COWARD and Sallie COWARD married a sister and brother, Lou and Will NOR-TON, making these two groups doubly kin. What you might not know, is that Lou and Will's mother was Susan ZACHARY. Susan's nephew, "Kit" ZACHARY, married Mary COWARD, making the COWARD-NORTONS doubly related to Mary COWARD-ZACHARY'S descendants. Eleanora ZACHARY married Oscar B. COWARD, as his 2nd wife, so her children are also doubly related to Dave's and Sallie's descendants. Eleanora's mother was also a ROGERS. Is that the same ROGERS family as ours?

Lou NORTON COWARD and Will NORTON'S brother, James Edward, married a niece of Jane ROGERS, which makes most of the family related to his descendants.

There are also a lot of HOOPERS -- Emma Norton HOOPER and Woodie ZACHARY HOOPER. Are these HOOPERS of the same family?

From Alabams State Archives, "Biographical Memoranda," probably COMART Surname File. Information was given by B. J. COMART Nov. 9, 1930.

"Biography of Bartow Johnson COWART"

Bartow Johnson COWART of Haleyville, AL, was born
May 13, 1872, near Double Springs, Winston Co., AL.
His father was Thomas Jefferson COWART, b. 1833, Towns
Co., GA; and his mother was Lydia CHASTAIN COWART; and
they lived in Georgia until 1865, when they moved to
Winston Co., AL, where they lived for the remainder of
their lives. Thomas J. COWART served 4 years in the
Confederate Army. He was Superintendent of Education
in Winston County for two terms.

Bart COWART was educated in the public schools of Winston Co., graduating from Godfrey High School, which was located at Motes, under the principalship of Prof. Allen M. WEILER. He had no college education, but he studied vocal music in various normal schools taught by Prof. Stephen J. Oslin, secured a diploma, and taught vocal music in schools from 1890 until 1900.

Bart COWART entered the newspaper field in 1900 as publisher and owner of "New Era" at Double Springs, AL. He engaged in the mercantile business at Double Springs in 1903 and remained there until 1910. He then moved to Nauvoo, Walker Co., AL, and re-entered the mercantile business there until 1920, at which time he moved to Haleyville, AL, and secured the Ford Agency for Winston County and continued same until 1929. He was also Vice President, Traders and Farmers Bank, at Haleyville, and a member of the Board of Directors, First National Bank, Jasper, AL.

Bart COWART was born a Democrat -- always a Democrat. He served as a member of the Democratic Executive Committee of Winston Co., AL, for several terms, and he was a member of the Board of Registration of Winston County from 1900-1904 and 1908.

Bart COWART was one of three editors and compilers of "Sumlight Praise," a gospel song book, containing 128 pages, published by Eureka Publishing Company.

On February 19, 1891, Bart COWART married Mary Elizabeth HILTON, at her home near Double Springs, AL. Her father was George Washington HILTON, and her mother was Gemins Catharine HILTON.

Mary Elizabeth and Bart COWART had 5 children: (1)
Barnett Coleman COWART, wife Louise. (2) Nellie Belle
COWART, who married Fletcher W. CORBIN. (3) Cora Mae
COWART, who married Hiram J. HYDE. (4) Lacy COWART who
never married. (5) Oliver Underwood COWART, who also
never married. All lived at Haleyville, AL, except
Cora Mae & Hiram HYDE, who lived at Nauvoo, AL.

[ADDENDUM: Bart COWART died at Haleyville, AL, 5
Jul 1954 and was buried on 7 July 1954 at Fairview Cemetery near Double Springs, Winston CO, AL. He was a grandson of Jonathan COWART, Jr., and Sarah (Sallie)
BARNES. Mary Elizabeth HILTON COWART died 18 May 1963
at Haleyville and was buried 20 May 1963 at Fairview
Cemetery.]
