                   hundred and twelve poles to a Spanish oak South twenty degrees  
                   West fifty poles to a white oak Sapling South thirty two degrees west  
                   Eighty poles to a Gum Sapling South thirtyseven degrees East one  
                   hundred and fifty Six poles to ared oak and Linn in the head of a  
                   hollow North Twelve degrees East One hundred and fifty poles  
                   to the Beginning with its Appurtenances To have and to  
                   hold the Land Tract or parcel of Land with its Appurtenances to  
                   the said William Norton and His Heirs forever In witness whereof  
                   the said Edmund Randolph Esquire Governor of the Commonwealth  
                   of Virginia hath hereunto Set his hand and caused the lesser Seal of  
                   the Said Commonwealth to be affixed at Richmond on  
                   the Eighth day of August in the year of our Lord one  
                   Thousand Sevenhundred and Eighty Eight and of the
