The records show that James W. Terrell, 2nd Company A, Infantry Regiment, Thomas' Legion, North Carolina, Confederate States Army, enlisted April 9, 1862, age 32 years, height 5 feet 9 inches, fair complexion, blue eyes, yellow hair, occupation merchant and farmer, born in Rutherford County, N. C., residence Jackson County, N. C.

He was promoted Captain of the company July 19, 1862, and appointed Captain and Assistant Quartermaster of the regiment September 27, 1862.

He was appointed Captain and Assistant Quartermaster, Confederate States Army, November 25, 1864, to take rank November 12, 1864, and assigned to the same regiment.

On March 3, 1865, at Asheville, North Carolina he ~~accompanied~~ ~~forwarded~~ forwarded acceptance of the appointment and inclosed the Oath.

No later record of him has been found.
