Wife and Extr: Peggy, lend all land whereon I live, also 6 negroes, furniture, 3 (choice) horses, 3 cows and calves, 4 sows and pigs, 20 sheep, farming utensils, 3000 lbs. pork, 100 Bles corn, fodder, 1 breach and harness and all poultry. As each child comes of age or marries, they are to have 1 feather bed of furn, also \$1000. Also give wife \$100.. I wish that the school house built on my land by myself, Joshua Pender and Theroplulus Pender should remain on the lot whereon it now stands for the use of a school house and nothing else.
