

Will of Robert Rogers, written 13 Dec 1736, proven 11 Jun 1739, before W. Smith:

.
Robert Rogers, of Chowan Precinct. "Weak in body" To Thomas GALLOWAY -- a plantation where Sarah MUMFORD now lives joining John PRETTY; 1 negro child Nan.

.
To Mary GALLOWAY -- as much of my plantation as needed during her widowhood; use of negro woman Moll for 10 years & then she to my son Robert ROGERS.

.
To Grandson[s] Robert DANIELL and William ROGERS -- 630 acres in Bartee Precinct.

.
To Son Robert ROGERS -- negro slaves Jack and Moll during his lifetime & time to my sd 2 grandsons; my manor plantation after decease of sd Mary GALLOWAY, plantation where he now lives.

To Daughter Elizabeth the wife of Simon DANIEL -- 10s VA. Other legacies.
